



The Transatlantic Studies Program in Brussels and Berlin is a study-abroad seminar on European foreign and security policy in the transatlantic context. The seminar offers a unique combination of academic expertise and policy perspectives which will provide students with a better understanding of European security and transatlantic relations that cannot be achieved solely in a US classroom.

Participants will have the opportunity to attend lectures, briefings, discussions, and academic events delivered by experts in their field. In addition, students will visit important sites such as the European Commission, the Council of the European Union, NATO HQ, the German Foreign Ministry, and the German Parliament. In Brussels and Berlin, students will participate in political, cultural, and social events which will help further their understanding of the European Union and its relationship with the United States of America. A tour of the Battle of Berlin is also scheduled in the program.

This seminar will be led by Bush School faculty, and carries three semester credits and no language requirement.
